The City of Lincoln Fire Marshal was asked to visit our community in order to respond to a complaint about the use of fire pits. The Association has been asked to let everyone know about the City regulations concerning fire pits.

- A fire pit that contains a spark arrestor must be at least 15 feet away from a structure when in use.
- A fire pit without a spark arrestor must be at least 25 feet from a structure when in use.

These regulations mean that a fire pit can not be lit on the back porch of our townhomes because the patio is not 15 feet in depth.

Due to a recent fire within Allegrini Terrace involving a fire pit, the Fire Marshal advised the Association that they will issue citations for fires that do not meet the requirements set forth by the City. We ask for everyone's help in keeping our community safe for all residents.

Be watching for your June statement for directions on how to sign up for electronic withdrawals to pay your association fees. You will still have the option of paying via check, but this will give all residents an alternative option for paying their association fees.

If you are walking your dog or have them out in the yard...

Don't forget to pick up dog waste! If the mowing company cannot mow due to excessive dog waste, it will be necessary for the Association to hire a clean up crew with the homeowner being billed for the service.





Vent Cap Cover To Stop Roof Leaking

Many residents have noticed leaking from the plumbing vent in the upstairs bath, resulting in water marks on the ceiling. This is a very easy fix. A cap is placed over the vent pipe, which fills the gap that is allowing excess water to leak into the house under the shingles. We have made arrangements for a contractor to come and fix this issue at a cost of \$50 per house. Vinyl Wrap Of Door Frames

Residents have also commented on how the front and back doors become weathered and need painted each year. A few residents have had their doorframes wrapped in vinyl siding. This provides a maintenance free option and it looks great!
